PIANO

- 1. Bach: a Prelude & Fugue from The Well-Tempered Clavier, or Toccata, or Fantasia, or an opening movement from an English Suite or Partita
- 2. The first or third movements of a sonata by Haydn, Mozart, Beethoven, Schubert, or one of their contemporaries
- 3. A major Romantic or Impressionistic composition
- 4. A selection by a 20th-21st-century American (U.S.) composer in any style

ORGAN

- 1. Bach: a Prelude & Fugue, Toccata & Fugue, or another work containing a fugue
- 2. A work from the Romantic Period
- 3. A selection by a 20th-21st-century American (U.S.) composer in any style

VOICE

- 1. An aria from a Classical or Romantic opera
- 2. An aria from an oratorio by composers such as Bach, Haydn, Handel or Mendelssohn
- 3. Two songs in original languages, selected from Italian songs of the the 17th- & 18th-centuries or German and French songs from the Classical or Romantic Periods
- 4. A contemporary art song by and American (U.S.) composer or a selection by a 20th-21st-century American (U.S.) composer in any style

STRING

- 1. The first movement from a standard concerto
- 2. A work from the Romantic Period
- 3. A selection by a 20th-21st-century American (U.S.) composer in any style

WOODWIND

- 1. The first movement of a standard concerto
- 2. A complete sonata or other work of comparable difficulty from another period
- 3. A selection by a 20th-21st-century American (U.S.) composer in any style

BRASS

- 1. The first movement of a standard concerto
- 2. A complete sonata or other work of comparable difficulty from another period
- 3. A selection by a 20th-21st-century American (U.S.) composer in any style

PERCUSSION

- 1. A complete concerto or sonata
- 2. Two suitable works representing two of the following areas: snare drum, keyboard percussion, timpani, multi-percussion

GUITAR

- 1. The first movement from a standard concerto or sonata from the Baroque or Classical Periods (suggested works from the Baroque or Classical Periods are Minuets Op. 11 & 22, & Etudes by Sor, Paganini Sonatinas, Variations on a Theme of Handel or Sonatine, Op. 71 by Giuliani, movements from the Bach Lute Suites
- 2. One Romantic period work
- 3. A selection by a 20th-21st-century American (U.S.) composer in any style
